# Future Planning:

- Fire Management Assistance Grant (FMAG) for home hardening and defensible space.
- Creation of template documents for the landscape permitting process under the WUI Code requirements. The goal is to create buy-in through simplifying the process, provide examples, and educate on the value and appearance.
- Westridge fuels reduction and neighborhood education. Possible prescribed fire in the UGA.

## Future Planning:

- Creation of a *Firewise* Landscape example at the entrance to our city.
- Pursuing funding for a “Fire and Fuels” crew.
- Individual structure mapping utilizing fire risk mapping for prioritization.
- County CWPP and evaluate the need for a City of Wenatchee CWPP.
