



Wenatchee Convention Center Expansion – Weekly Construction Newsletter

Week of: 03/03/2025 – 03/07/2025

Safety:

- Construction teams will be seen in hard hats and high visibility vests (PPE).
- Site security fencing is installed to protect and clearly define the construction area.

Traffic and Pedestrian Flow:

- 1st Street between N Wenatchee Ave and N Columbia Street is closed.
- Additional truck traffic will be present along N Wenatchee Ave and N Columbia Ave.
- The angled parking stalls on the north side of Wenatchee Avenue will be closed on Wednesday, March 5th, from 6:00 AM to 5:30 PM.

On-Site Activities

- **Exterior and Roof**
 - Framing east exterior wall and entry door.
 - Intumescent fireproofing.
 - Fire suppression, plumbing, and electrical rough-in.
 - Exterior sheathing and weather barrier.
 - Installing metal decking.
 - Set mechanical equipment.
- **Interior Work**
 - Level 1: Plumbing, HVAC ducts, fire suppression, electrical rough-in.
 - Level 2: Fireproofing, wall and soffit framing, partition supports, electrical and fire suppression rough-in.
- **Fuji/Gala Renovation**
 - Operable glass wall installation.

Closures and Access:

- A portion of the service lot at the Convention Center will be closed and fenced off for a construction laydown area.
- The northeast corner of the public parking lot east of the Convention Center will be fenced off for a construction laydown area.
- Parking stalls in the public lot north of the convention center will be temporarily closed for material transport. These areas will be marked with traffic cones and caution tape.

Safety:

- Construction teams will be seen in hard hats and high visibility vests (PPE).
- Site security fencing is installed to protect and clearly define the construction area.

Traffic and Pedestrian Flow:

- 1st Street between N Wenatchee Ave and N Columbia Street is closed.
- Additional truck traffic will be present along N Wenatchee Ave and N Columbia Ave.

On-Site Activities

- **Loading Dock & Exterior Storage:**
 - Set louver and expansion joint.
 - Apply fluid air barrier (north wall, soffit).
 - Fire suppression rough-in.
 - Insulate and sheath soffit.
 - Install rigid insulation.
- **Area A – Level 1:**
 - Wall insulation.
 - Install high-wall GWB.
 - Plumbing & electrical in-wall rough-in.
- **Area A – Level 2:**
 - Wall and soffit framing.
 - Electrical & HVAC rough-in.
 - Install partition hangers/supports.
- **North Elevation:** Weather & air barrier.
- **East Elevation:** Sheathing, weather & air barrier.

Closures and Access:

- A portion of the service lot at the Convention Center will be closed and fenced off for a construction laydown area.
- The northeast corner of the public parking lot east of the Convention Center will be fenced off for a construction laydown area.

- Additional truck traffic will be present along N Wenatchee Ave and N Columbia Ave.

On-Site Activities

- **Loading Dock & Exterior Storage**
 - Brick veneer installation in progress.
- **Area A – Level 1**
 - Mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and fire protection rough-in continues.
- **Area A – Level 2**
 - Wall and soffit framing underway.
 - Installation of hollow metal door frames.
 - Mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and fire protection rough-in continues.
 - Partition hanger/support installation in progress.
- **North Elevation**
 - Weather and air barrier installation.
- **East Elevation**
 - Sheathing, weather, and air barrier installation.
- **Roof**
 - Installation of roof ship ladders.

- Additional truck traffic will be present along N Wenatchee Ave and N Columbia Ave.

On-Site Activities

- **Loading Dock & Exterior Storage**
 - Soffit insulation and sheathing.
- **Area A – Level 1**
 - Mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and fire protection rough-in continues.
 - Wall insulation.
- **Area A – Level 2**
 - Wall and soffit framing underway.
 - Mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and fire protection rough-in continues.
- **North Elevation**
 - Parapet cap.
- **East Elevation**
 - Rigid insulation.
- **South Elevation**
 - Head and soffit framing.
- **Roof**
 - Brick veneer and stucco installation at the low roof.
